

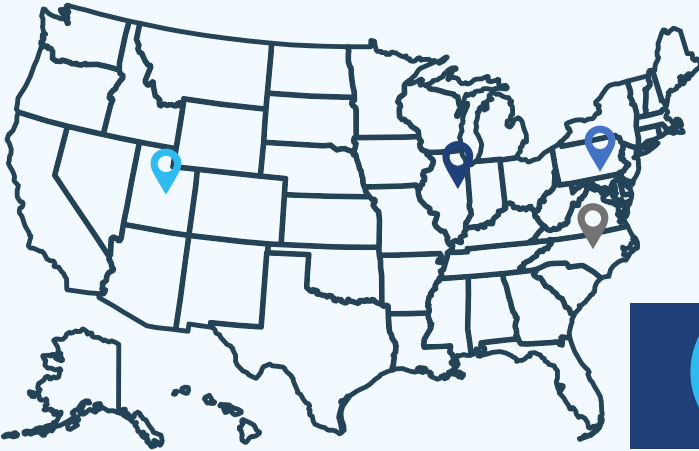

2 RESEARCH GRANTS

The following researchers will each receive a \$50,000, two-year research grant funded by ACPMP. ACPMP has now issued \$1,300,000 in the form of 27 promising research grants over the past 11 years designed to improve the diagnosis and treatment of Appendix Cancer and Pseudomyxoma Peritonei.

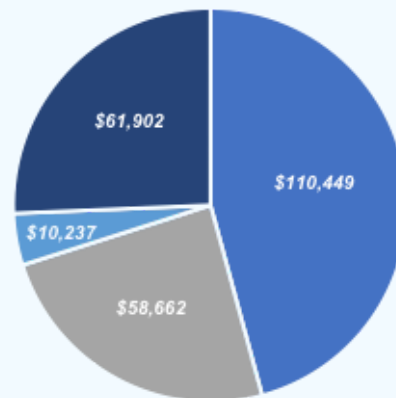

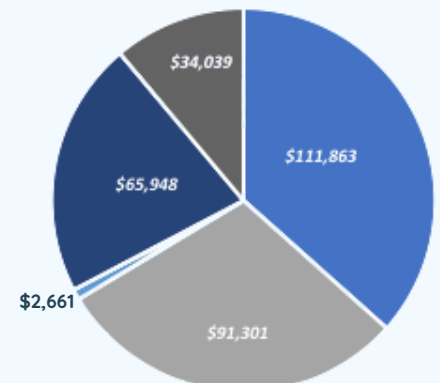
